INSTALLATION

1. Remove the vehicles head unit by following the manufacturer's instructions/guidelines. Once removed, disconnect all the power connections including the 8-pin connector.

2. With the aftermarket camera installed, connect the cameras RCA to the yellow RCA of the CAM-TY5-AD.

3. Connect the red & black 6V wires if the camera being used needs an 6V power supply.

Note: if installing a 12V camera, this will need to be powered by an alternative fused, ignition live 12V power supply from the vehicle.

4. Attach the 8-pin specific connector to the back of the head unit. When done, connect the power and test the reverse camera's functionality before reassembling the dashboard.



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
